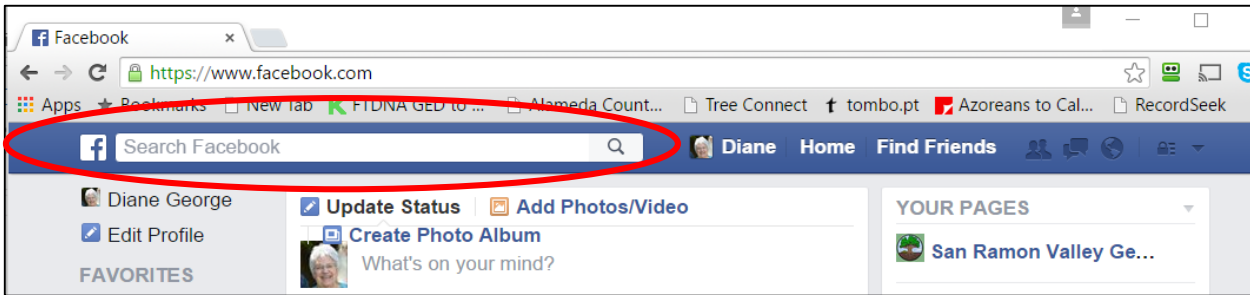
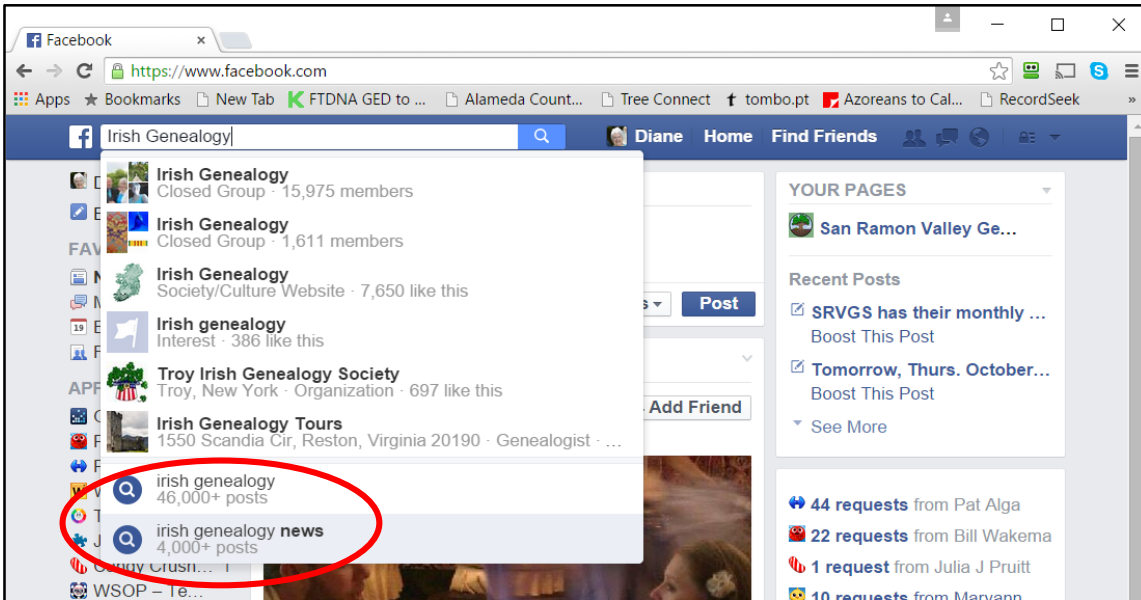


## Using Facebook for Genealogy

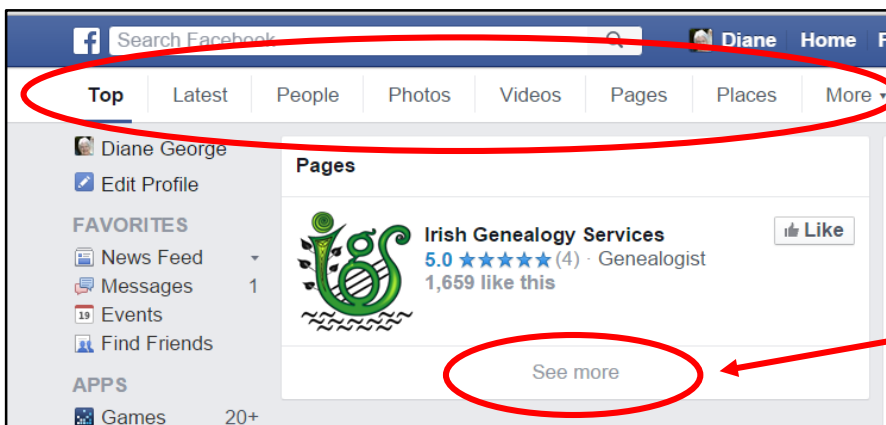
Use the Search box for doing genealogy searches. The Facebook search looks at all parts of Facebook, people, posts, pages, groups and more.



Enter terms to search for that include people and places, e.g., "Friends who like genealogy" or "Shapas and genealogy" or "Irish Genealogy." Experiment with different terminology.



Note that there are two items at the bottom of the list with a "magnifier" icon. Click on those to see even more results for your search terms.

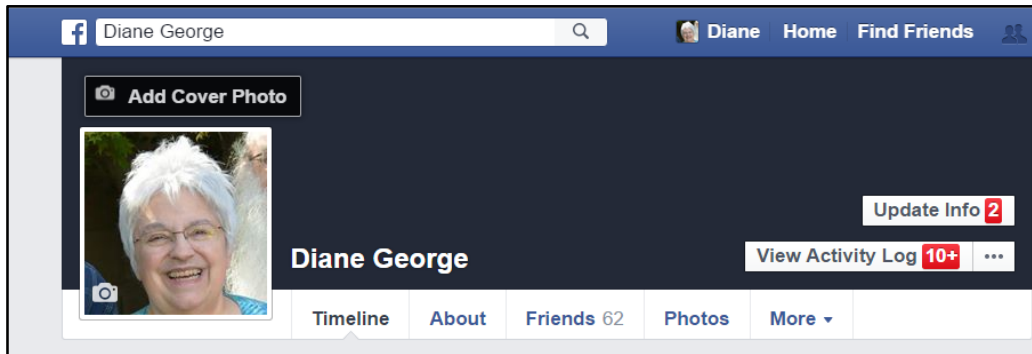


Use the links above the results to narrow the type of results, such as "Pages." Use the "More" link on the left to see additional choices.

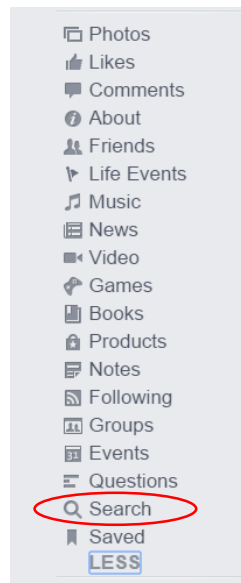
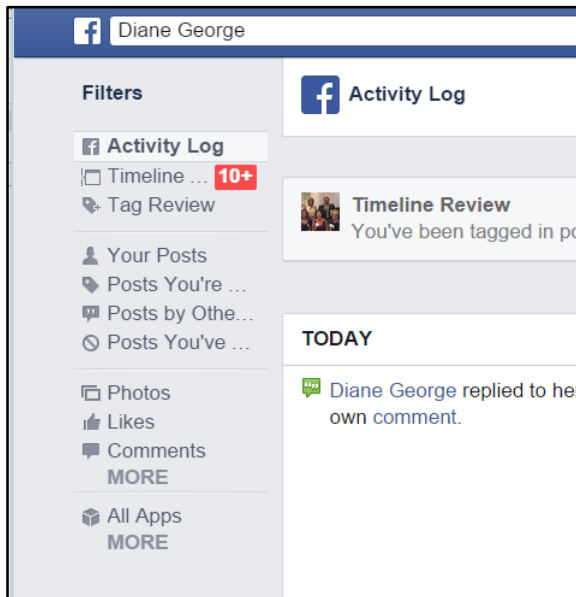
Always look for "See More" or "More" at the bottom of results of all types.

## Clearing Your Search History

Go to your profile by clicking on your name at the top of the window. Click on the “View Activity Log” button.

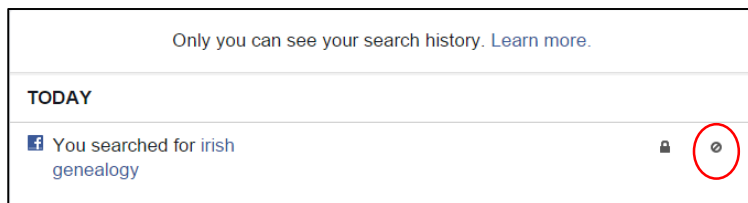


On the left side of the screen, you will see Filters. Choose the “More” under the word “Comments.” The list will grow:

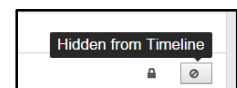


Select “Search” at the bottom of the list to see your past searches.
